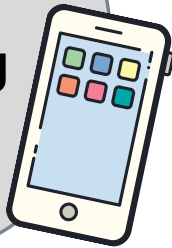

Racial/Ethnic minority
youth are

**2 TIMES MORE
LIKELY**

to be threatened or
injured with a weapon,
compared to white youth

What Parents Should Know

Youth that had a supportive adult to talk to were less likely to get in a physical fight



Youth that are exposed to violence at home or school are....

2 TIMES MORE LIKELY TO use substances, have depressive symptoms, and report poor mental health

3 TIMES MORE LIKELY TO get in a physical fight and purposely hurt themselves



Youth who were electronically bullied were 3 times more likely to consider attempting suicide
